

THE NIPPON FOUNDATION SPOGOMI WORLD CUP 2025

Organizer Agreement

EEYAN Inc. and Association of United Recyclers of Santo Domingo Este (ARESDE).(hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer") agree as follows (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement"), and as evidence of the formation of this Agreement, two (2) original copies of this Agreement shall be made and one (1) copy of this Agreement shall be held by each of the parties.

(Outsourcing)

Article1. EEYAN Inc. consigns to the Organizer the work of organizing the SPOGOMI WORLD CUP 2025 (to be held in November 2025) (hereinafter referred to as the "Competition") in a country or region approved by EEYAN Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Target Region") to be held in Japan (hereinafter referred to as the "Competition"). (hereinafter referred to as the "Services").

(Services)

Article2. The scope of services in this matter shall be as follows.

- 1 In compliance with the rules, etc. separately set by EEYAN Inc. and with the provision of goods, etc. determined by EEYAN Inc., an event (hereinafter referred to as the "Qualifiers Round") shall be held to determine the three Target Region Representatives (hereinafter referred to as the "Target Region Representatives") in the Competition, and the three winners of the Qualifiers, in principle, shall be selected as the Target Region Representatives and dispatched to the Competition. the Qualifiers shall be held at the Organizer's responsibility and expense (except for expenses separately agreed to be borne by EEYAN Inc.)In the event of a natural disaster, epidemics such as COVID-19, or other force majeure that makes it difficult to hold the Qualifiers (including difficulties due to government guidance, etc.), a separate consultation with EEYAN Inc. will be held.
- 2 Support the participation of the eligible regional representatives in the Competition according to the schedule set by EEYAN Inc. for the duration of the Competition.
- 3 One of the accompanying staff members must be able to interpret between their native language and Japanese or between their native language and English in order to support the Target Region Representatives.
- 4 Obtain written pledges from the Qualifiers participants that include the following A through D.
 - A) All copyrights and other intellectual property rights arising from participation in the Competition and the Qualifiers shall belong to EEYAN Inc. or a third party authorized by EEYAN Inc.

- B) Shall not exercise any moral rights such as name rights, portrait rights, privacy rights, publicity rights, moral rights of performers, and other moral rights of authors.
 - C) Participants in the Qualifiers who become the Target Region Representatives shall follow the schedule established by EEYAN Inc. during the period of this competition.
 - D) Cooperate as much as possible in media interviews, press conferences, campaign appearances, and other publicity and promotional activities for the Competition, if requested by EEYAN Inc.
- 5 The Organizer shall submit to EEYAN Inc. within the specified submission deadline using the format separately specified by EEYAN Inc. The language to be used shall be either Japanese or English.
- 6 Provide media coverage, press conferences, campaign appearances, and videos and photographs of the Qualifiers when requested by EEYAN Inc. (The rights to such videos and photographs shall be handled by the Organizer in accordance with this Article 4), and cooperate in other publicity and promotional activities conducted by EEYAN Inc. In addition, all rights under the Copyright Law (including but not limited to the rights under Article 27 and Article 28 of the Copyright Law in Japan) to the images and photographs provided by the Organizer shall be transferred to the General Incorporated Association Social Sports Initiative and the Nippon Foundation at the same time the images and photographs are generated. After the termination of this Agreement, the Organizer shall not exercise any moral rights of authorship and shall not raise any objection to the use by International SPOGOMI Federation, the Nippon Foundation, EEYAN Inc., or any third party authorized by them.
- 7 Cooperate in public relations by following International SPOGOMI Federation's media (website, SNS, etc.) and helping to spread the information.

(Term)

Article 3. This Agreement shall remain in effect from the date hereof until December 31, 2025.

- 2 The Organizer may not terminate this Agreement during the term of this Agreement, except as otherwise provided herein.
- 3 This Agreement shall not be automatically renewed. In addition, the Organizer shall not make any announcement of events, etc. related to the Competition after the expiration of the term of this Agreement at the stage where this Agreement is not renewed.

(Organizer's rights)

Article4. The Organizer shall have the right to

- 1 Reserve the right to use the trademarks of the Competition and materials provided by EEYAN Inc. in connection with the Competition and other events for the Qualifiers.
- 2 Have the right to produce posters, brochures, flyers, and other promotional materials to advertise the Competition and the Qualifiers within the Target Region and to conduct publicity and promotional activities with the consent of EEYAN Inc.

(Compliance, Prohibitions, etc.)

Article5. The Organizer has the following obligations.

- 1 The Organizer shall make every effort to organize the Qualifiers with 30 teams (3 per team) as much as possible. If the number of teams participating in the Qualifiers exceeds 30, the organizer shall try to limit the number of teams to 30 by drawing lots or other means.
- 2 The Organizer must not do anything that may damage the image of the Competition and must cease any activity that EEYAN Inc. deems to be detrimental to the image of the Competition, based on the instructions of EEYAN Inc.
- 3 The Organizer shall not engage in any conduct that is offensive to the law or to public order and morals.

(Attribution of Intellectual Property Rights)

Article6. The Organizer agrees that all rights under the Copyright Law (including but not limited to the rights under Article 27 and Article 28 of the Copyright Law in Japan), trademarks, design rights, publicity rights, and other intellectual property rights arising out of the Competition and the Qualifiers shall, upon their occurrence, be jointly owned by the General Incorporated Association Social Sports Initiative and The Nippon Foundation upon their occurrence.

- 2 The Organizer shall ensure that the Organizer, the Qualifiers participants, and the Target Region Representatives shall not exercise their moral rights of authorship or performers in connection with the Competition and the Qualifiers.
- 3 The Organizer shall not acquire any copyrights, trademarks, design rights, or other intellectual property rights related to the Competition during or after the term of this Agreement.
- 4 The Organizer shall not engage in any activities using "SPO GOMI," "SPOGOMI," or any other trademark or name associated with the Competition after the expiration of the term of this Agreement.

(Responding to Intellectual Property Infringements)

Article7. If the Organizer becomes aware of any infringement or risk of infringement of intellectual property rights or any other rights related to the Competition by a third party, the Organizer shall immediately notify EEYAN Inc. of such fact and respond to it in cooperation with EEYAN Inc.

(Outsourcing fee)

Article8. EEYAN Inc. shall pay to the Organizer for this Service fee (hereinafter referred to as the "Service Consignment Fee") by wire transfer in Japanese yen to the bank account designated by the Organizer. However, the Organizer shall bear the bank transfer fee.

2 EEYAN Inc. shall pay this Service Consignment Fee in two installments and at the following times as follows.

1 Approximately 50% of the total amount is due by the last day of the month following the month in which the date and venue of the Qualifiers are decided.

2 Approximately 50% of the total amount is due by the end of the month following the month in which the organizers submit the submissions designated by EEYAN Corporation after the completion of the Qualifiers.

(Obligations of EEYAN Inc.)

Article9. EEYAN Inc. has the following obligations to the Organizer.

1 The Target Region Representatives shall provide the necessary materials for the Competition.

2 To provide formatted data on materials, etc. to be submitted by the organizer.

3 To perform other duties to the extent deemed necessary by EEYAN Inc. to organize the Qualifiers and the Competition and to facilitate the participation of the Organizer and the Target Region Representatives.

(Cost-sharing)

Article10. EEYAN Inc. shall provide the Organizer with the items listed in the attached list necessary for the Qualifiers at a time and in a manner separately specified by EEYAN Inc. However, if it is difficult to provide the items, EEYAN Inc. will provide expenses in lieu of the items, and the method and timing of settlement will be discussed separately with the Organizer.

2 EEYAN Inc. will bear the following costs, specified in separate detail.

1 Travel expenses for the Target Region Representatives and one accompanying person to attend the Competition.

- 2 Expenses for the Target Region Representatives and one accompanying person to stay in Japan (lodging and meals) to participate in the Competition.
- 3 Other expenses as specified by EEYAN Inc.

(Declaration of Non-Anti-Social Forces)

Article11. The Organizer represents and warrants to EEYAN Inc. that the Organizer and the Target Region Representatives are not and will not be gangsters, gang-related persons, mafia, other groups engaged in violent or threatening illegal activities, or other Anti-Social Forces (collectively, "Anti-Social Forces").

(Prohibition of Assignment of Rights and Obligations)

Article12. The Organizer may not assign its rights and obligations under this Agreement or its contractual status without the written permission of EEYAN Inc.

(Confidentiality)

Article13. The Organizer shall not divulge or disclose to any third party any confidential information learned through the Competition or the Qualifiers during or after the term of this Agreement without the prior written consent of EEYAN Inc.

2 Nothing in the preceding paragraph shall apply to the information specified below.

- 1 The information already in the public domain at the time of disclosure from EEYAN Inc.
- 2 The information already in our possession at the time of disclosure from EEYAN Inc.
- 3 Originally developed information

(Cancellation of this Agreement)

Article14. In case the Organizer falls under any of the following, EEYAN Inc. may terminate this Agreement without any notice or compensation for damages to the Organizer, and demand compensation for damages suffered by EEYAN Inc. from the former Organizer who has been terminated from the Agreement. In the event that the notice of cancellation is not received by the Organizer, this Agreement shall be deemed terminated when it becomes clear that the notice of cancellation has not been received. In addition, termination under this Article shall be effective only prospectively.

- 1 In the event that the Organizer violates this Agreement and the violation is not corrected within a specified period of time after

- EEYAN Inc. has notified the Organizer by email of the violation within a specified period of time for correction.
- 2 If the deadline for submission of the designated items by the organizer has passed, and there is a risk of disruption to the operation of the event.
 - 3 The Organizer or any of its affiliates has engaged in sexual harassment, non-payment of remuneration, violence, unauthorized use of copyrighted materials, or any other conduct that has harmed or may harm the image of the Competition (not limited to cases related to the Qualifiers).
 - 4 Any changes to the rules and regulations of the Qualifiers without the permission of EEYAN Inc.
 - 5 In the event that the organizer fails due to the commencement of bankruptcy proceedings, civil rehabilitation proceedings, corporate reorganization, special liquidation, or similar proceedings.
 - 6 In the event of a crime committed by the Organizer or its associates.
 - 7 In the event that the Organizer could not be contacted for more than 1 month.
 - 8 In the event that EEYAN Inc. determines that the Qualifiers shall not be held or that the Qualifiers could not be held.
 - 9 In addition to the above, if there is a serious change in the property status, credit status, or business content of the Organizer, objective circumstances arise that make it difficult for the Organizer to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement.

(Termination of contract from the Organizer)

Article 15. The Organizer may terminate this Agreement in any of the following cases. In the event that the notice of termination is not received by EEYAN Inc., this Agreement shall be deemed terminated when it becomes clear that the notice of termination has not been received. In addition, termination under this Article shall be effective only prospectively.

- 1 In the event that EEYAN Inc. violates this Agreement and the Organizer has not corrected the violation within a period of thirty (30) days after having notified EEYAN Inc. of the violation by email or mail.
- 2 In the event that the Competition is not held due to reasons attributable to EEYAN Inc.
- 3 In the event that EEYAN Inc. fails due to the commencement of bankruptcy proceedings, civil rehabilitation proceedings, corporate reorganization, special liquidation, or other similar proceedings.
- 4 In the event that EEYAN Inc. could not be contacted for more than 1 month.

5 In addition to the above, if there is a material change in the property status, credit status or business of EEYAN Inc. and objective circumstances arise that make it difficult for EEYAN Inc. to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement.

(Resolving upon Consultation)

Article16. The Organizer and EEYAN Inc. shall comply with this Agreement and shall consult with each other in good faith to resolve any matter not stipulated herein and any question that may arise regarding the interpretation of this Agreement.

(Governing Law / Agreed Jurisdiction)


Article17. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Japan, and the Kobe District Court shall have exclusive jurisdiction in the first instance over any and all disputes arising out of this Agreement.
